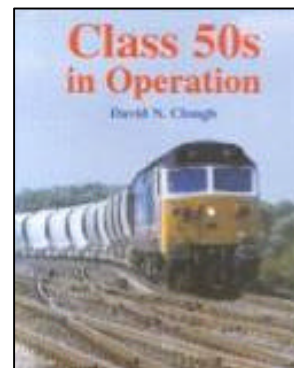

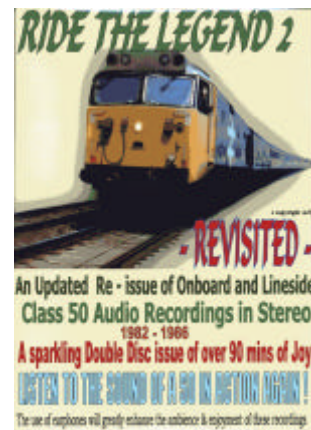
Ride the Legend – Revisited - Audio CDs (Allan Tebbs)

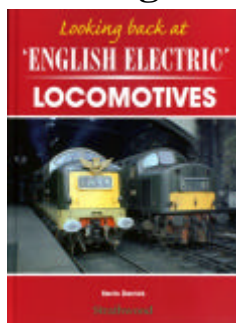

The photos depict locos at work on wide range of services, from “out of the box” new, to work shabby and even part cut up at the scrap yard. Most subclasses and livery variations are depicted at are a wide range of locations, on shed, in service and even off the rails completely. 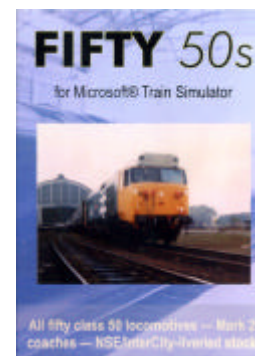
Class 50s for the Microsoft® Train Simulator

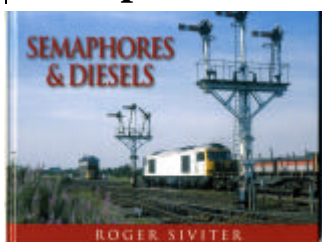
This add on pack adds all fifty class 50s in a range of appropriate liveries from before refurbishment to the end of service. Thus allowing you to drive your favourite 50 on the routes you have already installed on your PC.

As a bonus, this pack contains Mk1 and Mk2 coaches in BR Blue/Grey, InterCity and Network SouthEast liveries, and DCWA engineers pool wagons. It also includes a number of additional activities that work with the Settle and Carlisle route supplied as part of Microsoft® Train Simulator. The developers of this add on pack believe this is the only way you can currently get Class 50's, Mk II and Network SouthEast-liveried stock - so it should have wider interest for virtual operators of British Rail trains from 1967 through to 1993.

Semaphores and Diesels (Roger Siviter Great Bear Publishing)



With excellent railway photographs and the classic combination of Diesels and Semaphore signals this book is a winner. Many of the locations featured no longer have the signals, and in some cases track. The locos, and rolling stock are also lost to the tide of progress. Roger's high-class photographs bring back memories of that time, when real trains ran on railways with historic infrastructure and each station had a signal box and each region had its own style of posts and signals. As ever, each photo is accompanied by an informative caption detailing the working, location and many points of interest.

Unlike Roger's previous books this one covers the whole of the UK mainland.

The 50 Terminator (Locomaster Profiles) 26th March 2009 was the 15th anniversary of the running of the '50 Terminator' rail-tour, and to mark the occasion Locomaster Profiles re-released the programme of the same name on DVD.

At the time of the original release of this programme on VHS, production constraints meant that its running time was limited to just 60 minutes. The forthcoming digitally re-mastered version on DVD will be almost double that!!

For the record; 50 007 *Sir Edward Elgar* and 50 050 *Fearless* travelled over some 600 miles of routes that had a close association with the class. Starting at Waterloo the tour ran via Woking to Salisbury and then over 'The Mule' to Exeter. From there the train reversed before continuing over the south Devon banks to Plymouth and Penzance. The farewell tour culminated with a run from Penzance to London Paddington.

This programme has just about everything – challenging gradients, serious thrash, fine scenery, semaphore signals, plenty of sunshine and perfectly captures the day's historic events as hundreds of people turned out to witness the last Class 50 hauled train on British Rail. And you can see and hear it all from the best seat on the train!

Plymouth's former Area Fleet Manager Geoff Hudson recalls a historic and memorable day competing with 32 cylinders to provide the sound track for the programme.

This was Locomaster's very first 'Wired for Sound' cab ride, and such was its popularity that it started a whole series of programmes!

The Way Forward charts four years of preservation and main line activities of The Fifty Fund from November 2001 to December 2005. This period has seen the Fund's three locomotives - 50 031, 50 035 and 50 044 - together with Project Defiance's 50 049, fly the flag for their class in preservation and on the main line. In this comprehensive documentary: Jon Dunster (Fifty Fund Chairman from 1992-2006) recalls the highlights of this exciting period.

50 031 Hood at Poulton -le-Fylde on the Blackpool North branch, it's trip to Ashford in Kent, its visit to the Mid Hants 2004 diesel gala together with its Brighton Belle' excursion to Brighton, the first 50 back at Kings Cross since BR days, its return to former Southern haunts at Vauxhall and New Malden.

50 031 with 50 049 Defiance workings include: the GTRM Auto-ballaster from Bescot to Kidderminster and over the SVR, towing kettle 'Union of South Africa from Crewe to Carlisle, their trip to the EWS St Blaxey staff open day, their visit to North Wales to collect 47 750, their trip to Kingswear, their appearance at Arriva's loco-hauled Rhymney farewell event - and the series of Riviera's Blue Train excursions in 2002. Also included is extensive coverage of their ground-breaking visit to Fort William, Mallaig and Dundee in March 2005.

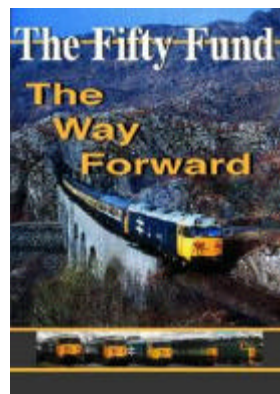

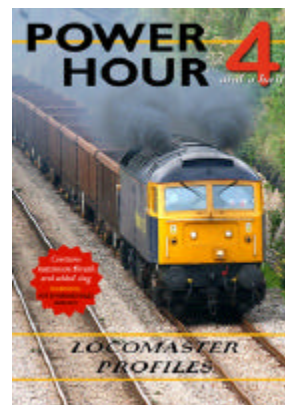
